COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED BY COVID-19 AND RELATED CORONAVIRUS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This Administrative Order is being issued in response to the recent outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Nevada. On March 15, 2020, Governor Stephen Sisolak declared a state of emergency and closed all public, private and charter schools K-12 until April 6, 2020 to prevent the spread of the virus. After review of the Nevada Supreme Court recommendation to stay jury trials and review of other Nevada Courts in the state with respect to modifying operations, the First Judicial District Court and the Carson City Justice/Municipal Court finds that taking this action to suspend jury trials in civil and criminal cases protects the community and outweighs the interests of the parties and the public in a speedy trial or hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court and the Carson City Justice/Municipal Court will identify non-essential court cases that can be rescheduled or be

heard by video conference or teleconference. Reasonable notice will be given to the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall operate to stay jury trials in civil and criminal cases for a period of not less than 30 days. The time period of any continuance entered as a result of this order shall be excluded for purposes of calculating speedy trial under NRS 178.556(1) and NRS 174.511. This order operates to stay trials in civil cases for purposes of NRCP 41 (e). The Court may extend the period of exclusion as circumstances warrant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Offices will continue to accept filings and operate with normal working hours.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attached Notice "Exhibit A" will be placed on the court's website and in front of the Carson City Courthouse located at 885 E. Musser Street, Carson City, NV 89701, the Juvenile Court located at 1545 E. 5th Street, Carson City, NV 89701, and the Juvenile Probation building located at 740 S. Saliman Road Carson City, NV 89701 and the Juvenile Detention Center located at 1545 E. 5th Street, Carson City, NV 89701.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Security located at the above-named facilities will be provided with instruction to inform the public of these precautionary measures for the prevention of spreading the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Anyone identified as being ill as described in "Exhibit A" will be denied entry. Reasonable force may be used.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Order will continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office disseminate copies of the order to Carson City City's Manager, Carson City District Attorney, Nevada State Public Defender, and Carson City Sheriff's Office.

You reside or have had close contact with someone who has travelled to one of the above areas within the last 14 days.
